1. REPORTING ENTITY

2. SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

(a) Statement of compliance

These income and expenditure account and notes thereto have been prepared in accordance with all applicable Hong Kong Financial Reporting Standards (HKFRS), which collective term includes all applicable individual Hong Kong Financial Reporting Standards, Hong Kong Accounting Standards (HKAS) and Interpretations issued by the Hong Kong Institute of Certified Public Accountants (HKICPA), accounting principles generally accepted in Hong Kong and the requirements of the Hong Kong Companies Ordinance.

(b) Recognition of revenue

Income is recognized when cash received and the significant risks and rewards of ownership have been transferred to the buyer.

(c) Taxation

Provision for taxation is not required as the Event has been exempted from Hong Kong Profits Tax under Section 88 of the Inland Revenue Ordinance.
